Acanthus mollis

Acanthus spinosa (Bear's Breeches)

Agastache (i.e., 'Blue Fortune,' rupestris, or 'Golden Jubilee' varieties)

Allium bulbs, named, large bulb, minimum of one or two, depending on size

Anemone japonica, named

Arisaema, nursery grown only (i.e., Jack-in-the-Pulpit)

Astilbes, named

Athyrium

Baptisia

Brunnera (i.e., 'Variegata,' 'Hadspen Cream,' 'Jack Frost,' and 'Looking Glass')

Campanula punctata named only (i.e., 'Plum Wine,' 'Sarastro,' and 'Pantaloons')

Cimicifuga

Convallaria (white double or pink only)

Crocasmia

Daffodils, named (minimum of three)

Delphiniums, named perennial varieties

Dianthus, named (not biennials)

Dicentra spectabilis, eximia, and named cultivars

Digitalis, named, perennial varieties only

Echinacea newer cultivars (i.e., 'Fancy Frills,' 'Twilight,' 'Sunset,' 'Sunrise,' 'Vintage Wine,' and 'Razzmatazz')

Eryngium (i.e., 'Blue Jackpot' and 'Donard' varieties)

Ferns, named

Geranium, named only (but not the more common ones)

Grasses, named choice varieties (I need help with this one)

Helleborus

Hemerocallis, newer named varieties, exclude common (i.e., 'Stella')

Heuchera, named newer foliage varieties (i.e., 'Amethyst Myst,' 'Marmalade,' 'Frosted Violet,' and 'Lime Rickey')

Heucherella, named

Hostas all named except very common cultivars

Hydrangeas, named or variegated, also large un-named specimens

Iris ensata, Japanese, named

Iris, bearded, named

Iris, siberian, named, excludes common varieties (i.e., 'Caesar's Brother')

Lilies, named (i.e., oriental, asiatic, trumpet), minimum of two bulbs, no tiger lilies

Monarda, (i.e., 'Marshall's Delight,' 'Raspberry Wine,' and 'Jacob Cline')

Mukdenia 'Karasuba' (heuchera relative)

Nepeta, named (i.e., 'Walker's Low' and 'Dropmore')

Papaver orientalis, named

Penstemon, newer named cultivars

Peonies, named

Perovskia (Russian Sage)

Phlox, newer named varieties (i.e., 'Laura,' 'Starfire,' and 'David')

Polemonium, variegated only

Polygonatum, variegated, also large species

Primula, choice varieties (i.e., japonica and denticulata)

Pulmonaria (only choice, i.e., 'Apple Frost,' 'Cotton Cool,' 'Excalibur,' 'Silver Shimmer,' 'Spilt Milk,' 'David Ward,' 'Silverado,' 'Majeste')

Rodgersia

Sedum, named (i.e., 'Vera Jamison,' 'Rosy Glow,' 'Frosty Morn,' 'Matrona'), no common groundcovers

Shasta daisy named choice varieties (i.e., 'Becky')

Tiarella, named cultivars

Trillium, nursery grown only!

Verbascum, named

Viola Etain
